

# Job Security

## Social Studies 10-1

As you begin your careers in a few years, job security is a factor you should consider. Job security is assurance (or lack of it) that an employee has about the continuity of gainful employment for his or her work life. Job security usually arises from the terms of the contract of employment, collective bargaining agreement, or labor legislation that prevents arbitrary termination, layoffs, and lockouts. It may also be affected by general economic conditions.

The Government of Canada has created a very useful website called “Job Bank” which allows you to search for jobs, explore careers, and see job market trends (employment rates, average wage, vacancies, etc.). The report is to address the following areas *\*each of these areas should be its own subsection:*

- A description of the job and the duties of the job
- Where can a person do that job?
- What training is needed for the job?
- Where can one get that training? Name a specific school and its location
- How much will that training cost?
- Are added training or requirements needed to keep that job?
- Are there any specific skills required?
- Discuss high school skills or classes that would be helpful to you if you want to do this job
- What is the job outlook nationally?
- What is the job outlook for this job in Alberta?
- What salary can you expect?
- Are there any other points of information that would be useful to a person considering this career?
